- The share of technology in total GDP will have doubled from 5% to 10% by 2030.
- The digital transformation that was anticipated to have been occurring over the next 10 years is happening today.

- When a **1,300-foot** ship blocked the Suez Canal and disrupted global shipping, our partner **Blue Yonder** made use of Microsoft artificial intelligence technologies to help its customers in finding alternative sources of supply of products worth more than **\$ 500 million**, to which the delay related.
- Surgeons from the Mt. Sinai Health System in New York and the Kyabirwa Surgical Centre in Uganda have jointly performed over 500 surgeries using mixed reality technology that renders New York City doctors possible to provide annotated recommendations that pop into their Ugandan colleagues' field of vision – despite they are parted by thousands of miles.
